Dixiland	July 14

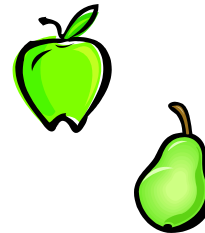


### New Varieties

- Regal – ripens 5/10-5/20; 700 chill hours; yellow, semi-cling
- Bounty – ripens 7/1-7/15; 850 chill hours
- Majestic – ripens 7/15-7/20; 850 chill hours
- \* **In alkaline soils use Lovell or Halford rootstock**

 \*Use M1-11 or M7 rootstock



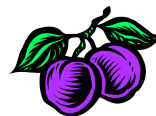
